Free social gathering held the first Thursday of each month at various Twin Cities breweries.



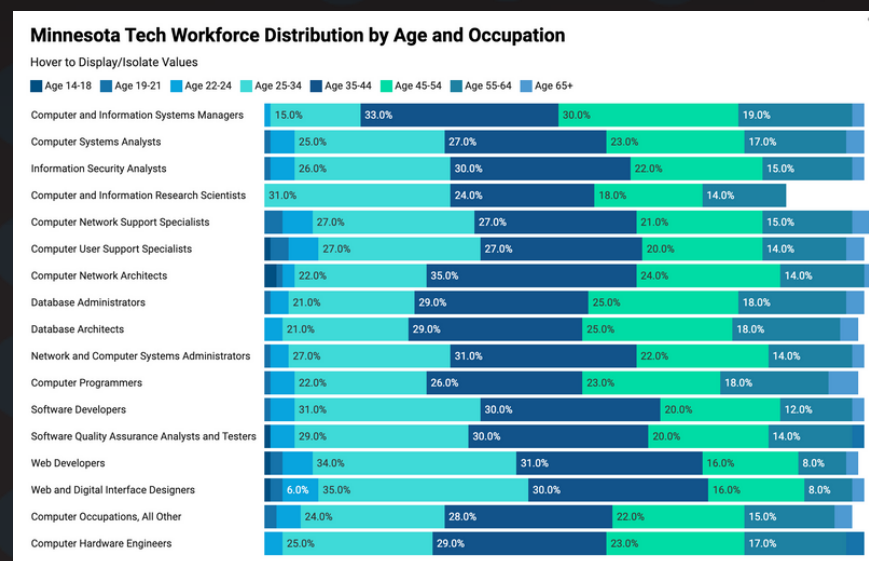
